#### **FUND RAISING FOR 2015**

Once again we have had a successful fund raising programme this year. Thank you to all those who have helped with this – you know who you are!

Here is a breakdown of what the bonfire society has raised so far this year: fetes/quizzes have made around £600, jumble sales around £350, membership over £1000 and other fundraising/donations £190. We also claimed back over £500 in gift aid on the previous two years' memberships.

## **BONFIRE SOCIETY FUNDS**

Information for our newer members: The money raised by South Heighton Bonfire Society goes to the South Heighton Village Hall Management Committee funds (i.e. the funds are merged). The Village Hall Committee (which is a charity) organises other events like the old music festival and South Heighton fete and, when the Bonfire Society was started by the Village Hall as a tentative move to see if it was successful (which it obviously was!), it was decided to keep it under the umbrella of the Village Hall Management Committee. There are two important reasons for this: (1) insurance cover and (2) if (touch wood) our bonfire night is rained off, or other fundraising efforts are not that successful, there should always be sufficient funds held by the village hall to cover the cost of fireworks, materials for torches, etc etc, for our bonfire night. And, of course, we use the hall for torch making, torch dipping, and it's our base on our own night. This is a good arrangement for the bonfire society.
